I qualified in the electronics industry in the early 90's, but have been active in the computer industry since 1988 (started off on DOS 2.11, Lotus 123 and MultiMate). The first couple of years were spent behind a repair bench, followed by on-site support. I started my own company in 2003, and have since been self-employed.

I have been active on the WUG since July 2013, starting off with a Groove and 27dB grid on a 3m pole. This setup ended being shelved within a week due to signal issues (damn trees), and within 6 months I was running a (mainly) transit highsite in the area (currently 4 BB's, one of which is to Paarl). I am also keen on things like the SXT noise shield (this is right up the area of expertise, Radio Engineering was one of my subjects), and have proven that shielding can drastically improve both noise pollution on these devices as well as increased signal strength. Very soon we will be testing the "prototype CPE shield" (the other one was a sector shield) to determine whether those gains could be further improved, maybe enough to even convince staunch SXT-haters that these devices DO have a decent place in CTWUG. This is course not a blanket acceptance, each device has its limitations, and should be handled accordingly.
